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

Volunteer Considerations

- Signups are for a single position only
 - Chaperone != Uniforms != Roadie != Plume Wranglers
- Except for plume wranglers, you are welcome to volunteer for any position
 - Plumes (\$\$) handled by specially trained volunteers only
- Children are not permitted to volunteer for tournament events
 - Safety
 - Distraction
- · Former students may volunteer with special permission

Volunteer Considerations (II)

- Volunteers MUST sign up! (Even "regulars")
 - Goal is to get the correct number of volunteers
 - Limited space
 - Limited field access
 - Limited ability to direct activities
- · Please sign up early. Don't leave us hanging.
- · If your circumstances change, please cancel your signup.

Volunteer Role

- KR is a SMHS activity. Responsibility for student welfare and discipline rests with the Music Directors
 - MOST disciplinary matters will be handled by the Directors, Staff, or KR Leadership without parent volunteer involvement.
 - The Directors may <u>explicitly identify</u> parent volunteers to assume limited disciplinary roles.
 - ANY parent is encouraged to step in in the case of a clear physical danger to any student.
 - Volunteers will report discipline issues to the KR leadership for further action.

Volunteer Role (II)

- Volunteers do what the students can not do for themselves
 - Safety Concerns
 - Time constraints
- Students are expected to do as much as possible to support and run their own program!

Volunteer Conduct

- SMHSMB is committed to providing a safe and enjoyable volunteer experience
 - All volunteers can expect respect and courtesy from parents, students, and staff and are expected to extend the same in return.

- · 3:45 Rehearsal ends
- 5:15 Depart for performance venue
- 6:15 Arrive at venue
- · 8:15 Perform
- 9:30 Awards
- 10:15 Depart for SMHS
- 11:00 Arrive SMHS and unload trucks / stow gear

The Volunteer Experience

- 12:30 The fun begins
 - Snacks delivered, inventoried, staged in boxes
- 1:00 Rehearsal starts
 - Early volunteer for staging/sorting/ repairs, etc.
- 3:15 Main Volunteer Call Time
 - Trucks arrive, load uniforms
- · 3:45 Rehearsal ends
 - Truck loading (pit, props)
 - Trucks depart for performance venue
 - Partial truck unload, set up hair station, lay out tarps
- 5:15 Buses depart for performance venue

But Wait! There's more!

- 6:15 Arrive at performance venue
 - · Hair / dress
 - · Performers depart for warmup area
 - Build props
- 8:45 Return to buses
 - Shakos deplumed, students change, herd watered and fed
 - Trucks loaded and secured
- 9:30 Awards
 - Roadies / moms watch from field
- 10:15 Depart for SMHS
- 11:00 Arrive SMHS
 - Unload trucks
- 11:30 Done for the day!

Do I need to bring anything?

- Blue KR Volunteer Shirt
 - Provided to adults who register for 3 or more events
- Jacket for cold evenings
- Gloves
- Headlight
- \$\$ for dinner / snacks
 - Please support the tournament sponsors!
- Patience and sense of humor

Tournament transportation


- Chaperones must ride the buses
- The buses will not accommodate all volunteers other than chaperones
- Suggest carpooling to the events!
- Volunteers will not park with the buses




- We are handling HEAVY / POINTY / BREAKABLE stuff

Performance Notes

- Be inconspicuous as we prepare to enter the field
- ~ Four minutes to move onto the field
 - [SCSBOA] "San Marcos, the judges are ready"
- Do NOT help with electrical connections unless specifically asked to do so by a staff member
- At the end of the performance, move everything directly off the field
 - Clock does not stop until everything is off the field
 - Penalty for overtime performance may be assessed
